

Epic Earth Arts Store Store Artist Agreement

This Store Artist Agreement (“Agreement”) is entered into between Epic Earth Arts (“EEA”) and the undersigned artist (“Artist”) for participation in the Epic Earth Arts Store located at www.epiceartharts.store.

1. Purpose

The Epic Earth Arts Store is a curated online shop featuring original artwork by artists who actively contribute to the Epic Earth Arts creative community.

2. Eligibility

Participation is limited to artists who are active members at Level 3 or higher within the Epic Earth Arts community platform.

3. Relationship of the Parties

Artist is an independent contractor and not an employee, partner, or agent of Epic Earth Arts.

4. Artwork Listings

Artists may have a maximum of ten (10) active items listed in the Epic Earth Arts Store at any given time. Epic Earth Arts manages all listings.

5. Image Requirements

Images must be a minimum of 2000 pixels on the longest side, recommended 2500–3000 pixels, in JPG or PNG format, well-lit, accurately colored, and free of watermarks or text overlays.

6. Pricing & Commission

Epic Earth Arts retains a 25% commission on the listed item price only. Artists receive 75% of the item price. Shipping charges are paid by the buyer and are not commissionable. The 25% commission is the only fee retained by Epic Earth Arts in connection with store sales.

7. Shipping & Fulfillment

Artists are responsible for packaging and shipping sold artwork in a timely and professional manner and for providing valid tracking information to Epic Earth Arts.

8. Payments

Artist payments are issued once per month on the 15th of the following month, or the next business Monday if the 15th falls on a weekend. Payments are made via Zelle to the email address or phone number provided by the Artist. Artist is responsible for ensuring accurate payment information is on file. There are no additional platform, listing, or payout fees charged to

the Artist beyond the agreed commission. A valid shipping tracking number must be received before a payment will be made on any sold item.

9. Taxes & Reporting

Epic Earth Arts collects and remits all applicable sales tax. Artist is responsible for reporting income and must submit a completed W-9 prior to receiving payment. Epic Earth Arts will issue a 1099-NEC if earnings meet IRS reporting thresholds.

10. Copyright & Image Use

Artist retains full copyright to all artwork. Artist grants Epic Earth Arts a non-exclusive, royalty-free license to use submitted images for store display and promotional purposes related to Epic Earth Arts.

11. Termination

Either party may terminate participation with written notice. Outstanding orders will be fulfilled and final payments issued according to the standard payout schedule.

12. Governing Law

This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Arizona.
